\*RPS requires all high school students to complete 4 years of Religion. Students must also complete 10 hours of community service per year (at least 40 prior to graduation).

\*Satisfactory completion of two consecutive credits of the same world language is required for university entry.

\*\*One elective course must satisfy the Character Education requirement for high school graduation. Character Education courses at RPS include \*Bible, Career Research and Decision Making (0.5 credit) and Digital Information Technology (1 credit).
